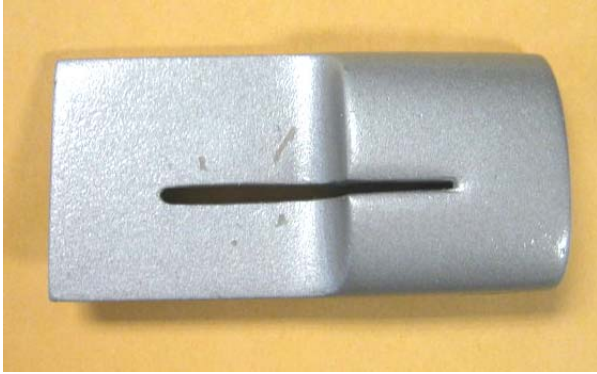

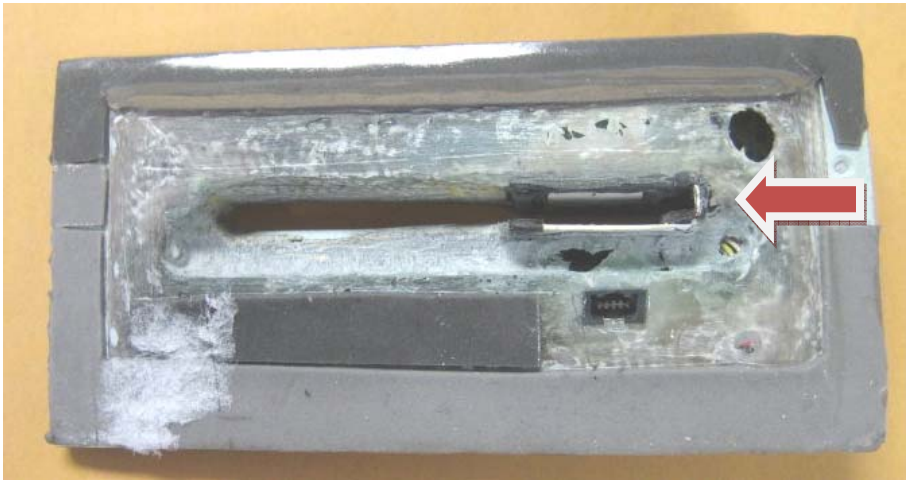
The camera is self contained (audio & video) and placed in a small plastic box. The box was designed to fit into the corner of the ATM framework and painted to match. The tape used was sufficient to maintain the box in position but the item was easily removed.



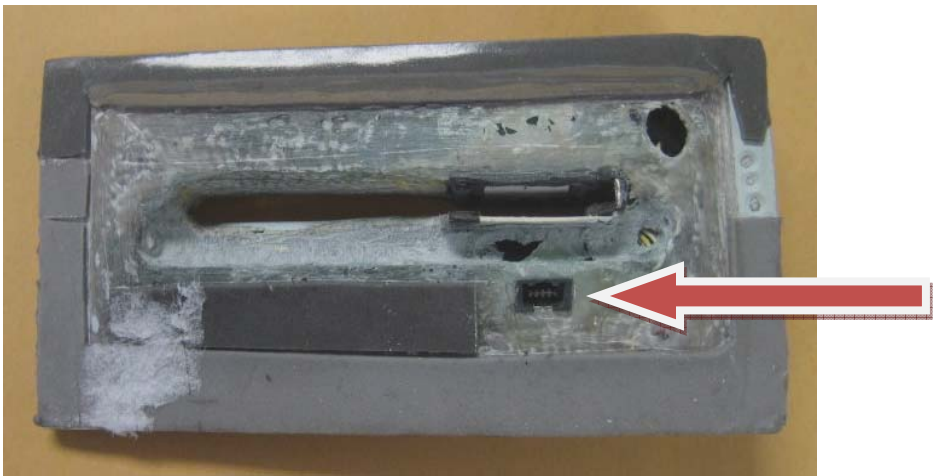




Front of Skimmer
